

## White Collar Update: Insulating Your Organization from Prosecution has Gotten Tricky in the Globalization Era

A promise of non-prosecution, or even a letter granting your client immunity, may not end the story. In our digitized-globalized era of multi-agency, multi-state, multi-district and multi-national investigations and prosecutions, assurances from one jurisdiction simply may not insulate a client from prosecution in jurisdictions either across the country or, as pertinently, around the globe. Ever increasing collaboration between state, federal and foreign law enforcement authorities poses risk, and protecting one's client has become a multi-dimensional chess game.
